Coding Calliope (K-5):



Students will learn coding using Ozobots, Go Robot Mouse, and Dash-n-Dot. Students will be encouraged to learn at their own pace. We will begin with some basics of coding logic. Students will be able to progress to using Blockly programs to code our tools. As we continue, we may use computer programs like Kodable, Scratch Jr., and Hour of Code to extend our learning.

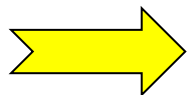
