Dear 7th & 8th Grade Parents/Guardians,

The BCS 7/8 Team is planning the end of year trip to Cedar Point Amusement Park in Sandusky, Ohio on **Thursday**, **June 13th**, **2019**.

Important points:

- Leave from BCS on June 13th at 7:00 A.M. Students must be at school no later than 6:45 A.M.
- Round trip transportation will be provided by private motorcoach (tour company is Bianco).
- Students will be in Cedar Point Park from 9:30 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.
- Please pick up your child at 8:00 P.M. when we return to BCS.
- The Cedar Point trip fee is \$70, covering private motorcoach costs and admission to the park. Due to the fixed costs for group rates and transportation, we cannot make refunds for this trip.
- Food & spending money will be the student's responsibility while at Cedar Point.

The adult to students' chaperone ratio will be approximately 1:15 for this trip. Students will be **required to select a specific buddy** and enjoy the park together for the day. BCS staff members will be available at a location in the park during the entire day to provide assistance to students. **We <u>REQUIRE</u> that all buddy groups check in at this location between 1:30-3:00 P.M.** Cedar Point has an excellent security department that monitors the park. A well-equipped clinic is also on the grounds to provide care and store medications. The security office and clinic will be notified of the BCS staff location.

We want our students to have a safe and enjoyable experience at Cedar Point. If your child does something that requires the security personnel at Cedar Point to detain him/her, you will be notified immediately. Cedar Point is in Ohio and possible legal involvement could require the presence of a parent/guardian before the student is released. Of course, we do not expect this type of behavior and expect all students to make good choices!

What if my child is not going on this trip?

• The *BPS Student Transportation Permission Form* must still be completed and signed and turned into Mr. Emmi.

How does my child sign-up to go on this trip?

- The sign-up will occur in <u>front of the cafeteria</u> from 8:00-8:14 A.M. on Monday, May 6th; Tuesday, May 7th; Wednesday, May 8th; and Thursday, May 9th.
- The buddy group must come to one of the designated sign-up times with his/her buddy and the completed BPS Student Transportation Permission Form and payment (check payable to BCS for \$70 or cash.)
- Once partnerships are formed and signed-up, they will not be changed.
