All registrations for after school classes must be completed through the Birmingham Community Education office.

To register for Community Education classes **online**, go to www.communityed.net

- Click on "Browse" in the left-hand column
- Select "After School Programs" under Youth Programs
- Choose the class(es) you wish to register for; enter "Add to Cart" for each class
- Sign in (or create a sign in if new user)
- Enter credit card payment information

Optionally, you may **register by phone** at 248-203-3800.

REFUND POLICY: No refunds will be issued once class begins. Tuition will not be prorated for lack of attendance or schedule conflicts. Refund requests must be made directly to Birmingham Community Education 3 days prior to the beginning of class. With the exception of one day classes, all class refunds are the amount of the tuition less a \$10 processing fee per class. The processing fee for one-day classes is \$5.00. The cost of materials cannot be refunded.

Please note that classes have both maximum enrollment limits, as well as minimums that must be met in order to run the class. Early registration is encouraged!

In addition to your online receipt, you will receive an email confirmation of your child's registration. Please be sure to respond to the request for dismissal information. If you will be picking your child up at class dismissal, you will be provided with the security code to enter the building.
