SCHOLAR is operated by a volunteer board of trustees including the Birmingham Public Schools' Superintendent, a member of the Birmingham Board of Education, a representative of the districtwide PTA, a representative of the AAUW, and at-large trustees drawn from the community. Additional honorary trustees may be appointed.

Students apply for scholarships in their high school senior year, and within two years of high school for collegiate tuition aid. Evaluation criteria include financial need, academics, school and community service, employment history, and exceptional family or individual circumstances.
