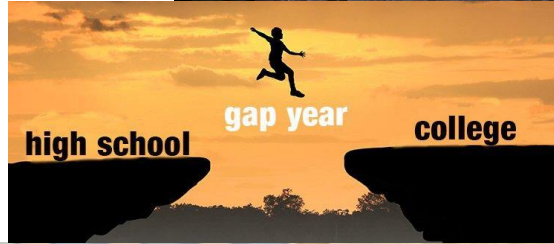

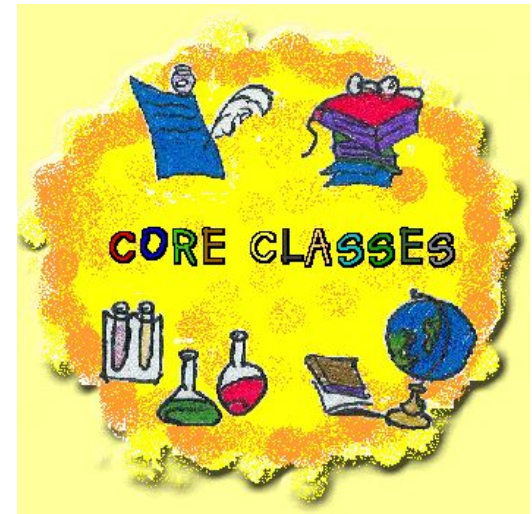

Requesting Honors and AP Courses

- **How to request an Honors or AP level class:** Have a conversation with teacher to be approved and teacher will add student's name to list.
- No signatures this year, but students must be recommended by their teacher and added to the approved list
- Counselors will review the Honors and AP recommendation lists to approve student course selections

- Pick alternate electives that you really want!
- Pick **17** class total
- Think about your post-secondary goals when you are choosing electives
