

#### Parent PowerSchool Upgrade and Account Viewing

Currently, when logging into PowerSchool to see your students' grades, the page will only show the classes and the absences and tardies list. If you want to see the grades and assignments, you will need to go to the top of the screen under the main title: **Grades and Attendance – "Student Name"**. There is a smaller tab that says Grades and Attendance. When you double click on it, the student's grades will be revealed in the grid, and when you click on a grade, it will take you to the assignments page for that subject. If you do not wish to see the grades, simply go to the navigation pane on the far left and click the heading "Grades and Attendance" and they will be hidden again.

#### Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT)

All 11th-grade students will be taking the PSAT on Wednesday, October 16, 2019, during the school day. The test measures a student's skills in two core areas: Mathematics and Evidence-Based Reading and Writing. This assessment provides students with a great opportunity to practice and refine skills by taking a standardized test in a timed environment. Junior students who take the PSAT can qualify for the National Merit Scholarship Competition and other scholarship programs. Because this is a practice test, there will be no makeups.


