Update on Hybrid Learning Plan

As of today, we plan to begin the hybrid learning option for high school students on January 19th. **If you have not made a learning plan selection (hybrid or virtual) for your student, please let me know what selection you would like to make as soon as possible via email.** Cohorts will be assigned for those families who have selected the hybrid option this week, and will be sent via email. Cohort A students will attend in-person on Mondays and Thursdays, and Cohort B students will attend in-person on Tuesdays and Fridays. Wednesdays will be virtual learning/livestreaming for ALL students. First hour class will begin at 8:10 a.m. every day as it does currently.

There will be no classes held this week on Thursday, January 7 and Friday, January 8. These two days will be an opportunity for our teachers to prepare their classrooms for hybrid learning, and to practice with the technology for instruction.

Our 9th Grade Transition Day will be on Wednesday, January 13th for students interested in attending this event on campus. Students who will attend a morning or afternoon session that day, and will be divided into smaller groups to learn how to navigate the building and will participate in activities led by Big Brothers Big Sisters. **ONLY 9th graders will not attend classes on January 13th.** All other students will attend classes regularly that day.
