We are hosting a "fan bus" for students who want to attend Friday's football game!

Kick-off the Groves Football season by attending the opening game on August 27th at Wayne State University! The varsity football team, cheer team and marching band have the honor of participating in the Xenith Prep Kickoff Classic. The game starts at 4:00pm and the bus will depart from Groves at 2:45pm. Students must ride the Fan Bus both to and from the game. Masks are required to be worn on the bus.

In order to participate, students must:

1. Purchase a ticket and show proof of purchase upon boarding the bus (tickets are available on line at <https://gofan.co/app/school/MI72381>). Tickets are \$12 and a Groves Family Pass can not be used for this game.

Space is limited to the first 70 students. There is no fee for riding the bus. In the event that there are fewer than 20 students signed up to ride the bus by 2:00 pm on Thursday August 26, the bus will be canceled (those who have signed up will be notified if this occurs).
