Reminders for In-Person Learning

Students will enter the building at the Pool Hall or cafeteria doors. Doors will open at 7:30 a.m. each morning, and students will need to show their completed Clear to Go health screener as they arrive. If you have not completed the Parent Agreement for your student to download Clear to Go, please do so as soon as you are able. This allows us to upload your student into the system.
