REPORT CARDS

Your child's NWEA report and final report card will be mailed to your home on June 18th. You may also view report cards online, they will be available starting Friday, June 18th at 4:00 pm, and will remain available for two weeks, closing at 8:00 am on July 6th. Please use the Power School account that you set up. **You will need to use a computer to access this portal. The mobile app will not work to view the report card.**

STUDENT MEDICATION PICK-UP

In keeping with Birmingham district policy, parents are to be notified that all medications administered to students must be removed from the school office at the end of each school year. We are asking you to please come to the school office and pick up your child's medication(s) before Noon on the last day of school (June 11th) or between 8am and 4pm day on Monday, June 14th. **All medications that are not retrieved will be disposed on Tuesday, June 15th.**

For safety reasons please understand that we cannot give the medication(s) to your student. A parent/guardian *must* pick them up personally.
