



Seaholm High School Mathematics Department Transfer Policy

Within the first three weeks of the trimester:

- Students may transfer to a different math course during the first three weeks (15 class periods) *with teacher approval*. They will be graded only on subsequent work in their new course, but be responsible for all of the content of the course in terms of future tests/quizzes and the final exam.

Between three and six weeks of the trimester:

- Students may transfer to a different math course between the third and sixth weeks (15 to 30 class periods) *with teacher and department head approval*. The grades from their previous course will count as 30% of their trimester grade. The grades from their new course will count as 50% of their trimester grade. The final exam will count as 20% of their trimester grade. Again, students will be responsible for all of the content of the course in terms of future tests/quizzes and the final exam.

After six weeks of the trimester:

- There will be no student transfers after six weeks (30 class periods). Students may Drop/Fail from the course after six weeks.
